We are really excited to say that we are going to hold our annual **Christmas Nativity and the Christmas Fair** at Willingdon Primary School on **Friday 5 December**. We are going to have the nativity called 'I Spy' at the school on the afternoon of **5 December at 2.15pm**. We would love all the children to come in for it (including all the children who do not normally attend the setting that day), dressed up in anything Christmassy (if they have it, but don't worry if they don't) ready to take part in their nativity. The children will sing the songs they will learn over the next few weeks and you will be sent a memo to find the songs via Tapestry to help learn the words too! If your child is already in the setting that day you are welcome to send in their clothes to change into and we can get them ready for you prior to your arrival.

We will then all stay in the school hall for the Christmas fair at the school to raise lots of pennies and have some fun! The stalls will include various tombolas, raffle, cakes, Christmas tattoos, games etc and a very special visitor! We have sent out a recent list giving details of all of the donations for the 'fair' which we hope you will be able to support us with. We also run a cake stall so any home-made or shop bought cakes would be gratefully received leading up to the week specified below.

- **Week beg 10 November** - please bring in any raffle or tombola prizes, such as vouchers, new books / toys, gifts, chocolate etc
